
### NALA News

NALA announced on May 5, 2014 that it had received accreditation of the Certified Paralegal program from the National Commission for Certifying Agencies (NCCA). The Accreditation is achieved by the submission of an application that demonstrates compliance with the NCCA's Standards for the Accreditation of Certification Programs. The NCCA has been accrediting certifying programs since 1987, basing its

accreditation on the highest quality standards in professional certification. PANJ wishes to congratulation NALA on receiving this accreditation.

NALA's 39th Annual Convention Institutes & Exhibition will be held in Charleston, South Carolina on July 23-25. The Convention will be comprised of six institutes or tracks, including Anatomy of a Case, Corporate, Discovery, Elder Law, Essential Skills and Intellectual Property.
